#### **JANUARY BOARD HIGHLIGHTS:**

- December financials were approved and budgets reviewed.
- Expansion Committee met with all levels of Government to secure funding for expansion of Legion Village
- Meal and Service increase was approved by the Board (5% as of July 1, 2025)
- The Foundation Board of Directors will be welcoming two new members. Chris Barker and Stan Jarvis. We welcome both new Directors to the Board.

#### **MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT:**

Jake Rouw, the Director of Building Maintenance and Housekeeping has sent a letter to all residents outlining the Fire Inspectors requirements for Legion Village. It is unfortunate that some of these requirements will affect residents, but we need to keep the safety of all residents in mind. Please read the requirements and please adhere to them for your safety and for the safety of all the residents and staff at Legion Village.

It is that time of year again, for our Fire Safety Inspections. Annual Fire Inspections will be taking place, with Trinity Fire on March  $24-26^{th}$  between the hours of 8:00 am -4:00 pm. Staff will accompany Trinity, and we will need access to your apartment. Residents do not need to be home for the fire inspection to be completed.

This is a reminder that if you have visitors that require entry to the building and can not reach you directly, they can enter 9876 to reach the front desk or the PSW's after hours.

We are in the process of upgrading the intercom system. This should address the issues some tenants may have been experiencing. Thank you for your patience and understanding.

And finally......

Thank you to all the residents and the Board Members that could attend the Resident Coffee Morning on February 18<sup>th</sup> to receive an update on the expansion of Legion Village. To summarize, we outlined that there are several geological and service studies that will be completed over the next several months as we comply with the Minor Variance recommendations made by the Committee of Adjustment. We are still seeking funding from the Provincial and Federal Government, as well as looking at securing finances through CMHC.

Currently, we are looking at Spring 2027 at the earliest to break ground. We will keep you updated as more information becomes available.
